





Both the public and the legal community believe campaign contributions influence judicial decisions. 





In 2021, more than 15 million ads for legal services aired on local television broadcast networks in the 210 media markets across the U.S., totaling approximately \$971.6 million spent. The crash occurred on a chilly morning in Bensalem Township, Pa., between a tractor-trailer and a passenger vehicle traveling at what witnesses described as a "relatively fast speed."
