






TRUCK DRIVERS ENROLLING IN GPA SYSTEM

FY 21: 3,294 drivers enrolled






U.S. PORTS Vessels at Anchor – March 28, 2022






U.S. PORTS Vessels at Anchor – June 17, 2022






SAVANNAH IMPORT DWELL DAYS January 2020 – May 2022






FY22 SAVANNAH IMPORTS 'On the Water'






SAVANNAH INDUSTRIAL MARKET 2008 – 1Q 2022





VACANCY RATE 2008 - Q1 2022






CHASSIS POOL



RISING INVENTORY vs. SALES FOR VARIOUS RETAILERS




